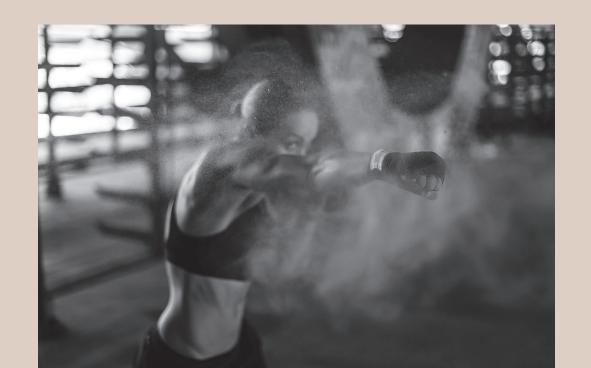
Innovation is the result of working with the creativity inherently present in a diverse team. It is known that the more cognitively diverse a team is, the more creativity potentially is released. Potentially. There are some conditions to be met. Team members should feel safe to share, they should be willing to take a modest position of "not knowing" and be ready to engage in clear yes constructive dialogue. People should feel safe to contribute and have a collective sense of curiosity and ambition to create new products and solutions. This workshop helps the team work on that.

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WAY-OF-WORKING

The workshop expects active participation from all on the team. We work with real-life cases and work on (innovation) dilemma's the team currently faces. A shared effort will be initiated to reshape the team culture and mutual respect. We continuously work on the team culture, without making this a "soft, touchy-feely event". On the contrary: new business ideas are the key focus. Team members will realize there is nothing soft about opening up.

This one-day workshop is provided in-company to teams of max. 6-15 participants. Two trainers facilitate the process (while in teams of 10 people of less we work with one trainer). In-company tariff for one day: € 2.495*. For the two-day version: € 4.195*.

TARGET GROUP

This workshop is for diverse teams who realize they could perform better if they were to improve the openness to each other's contribution and ideas. Teams that are ready to investigate how to work together better than they do today and release their creative powers.

We work with real-life cases the team brings in and investigate how the unique skills and characters of all on the team are used. We introduce models for collective generation and evaluation of new ideas, and give you tools to optimize the mutual respect, appreciation and communication within the team. Communication will be the central focus: we help the team find a balance between trust and safety on one side, while at the same time opening them up for intense discussion and disagreement.
